Accommodation

There were several requests on the equipment in the guest dormitory; more clothes hangers, shaving razors, TV set, bidet toilets. A request for changing towels every day.

- The clothes hangers will be increased to four in each room. We will consider to place a vending machine for amenities. The budget to install bidet toilets are recently secured and will be installed in FY2019.
- Opinion from the attendants in the users meeting was that there is no strong need for TVs in every room or changing towels everyday. There was unanimous consensus that keeping the current price is more important than making such improvement.
- There are some other requests after the meeting, mainly in the equipment in the kitchen and English instruction. We will keep improve on this within the budget constraint.

 Shuttle bus between J-PARC entrance and Tokai station stopped operation in 2015. Unfortunately there is no plan to resume the service. The instruction and time table of the public transportation will be available at the Users office and dormitory.

- We have taken simple inspection at every time after return as a routine work. We will consider to adopt regular maintenance, inspection and replacement, in addition.

Other opinions in the meeting

It is difficult to get bikes during the T2K meeting weeks.

• The Users office already have about one hundred and fifty bikes and it is sufficient for the most of the period. Having a large amount of bikes costs for the maintenance through the whole year so we are rather hesitant to increase significantly.

There is an idea for the bike sharing.

 The infrastructure of such system may cost more but we will investigate the option to install this partially.

IQBRC

Conference room at IQBRC 2nd floor is long in the vertical direction, so the rear seats are very far from the projection screen. Having extra Screens for projection at rear or side wall will give a better view for everyone.

The room (and the building) is owned by Ibaraki prefecture. We will
discuss with them if improvement is possible.

Other opinions in the meeting

It is nice if visitors can get the entrance card-keys on weekend. There is always a long queue in front of the building in the Monday morning of T2K week, waiting the open of the building.

• If you request in advance to the Users office, you can get a card key (and a key for your rent-a-bike) at the dormitory reception on weekend.

Miscellaneous

Opinions in the meeting

It is appreciated to have this meeting but unfortunately the number of attendance was not so high. Rather than relying on the e-mail announcement, it is better to have more direct contact with the experimental collaborations. For example, the active participation of the T2K-Young, which is founding in T2K and getting active, in the meeting organization may helps.

There are other uses meetings, more formal and seems-to-be Japanese only meeting. It is better to get the international participants for such committee.

- There are a formal committee with the User association in J-PARC. The meeting is held twice a year in Tokyo and the user representatives nominated by the Japanese user communities are the members. The formal procedure is the committee members collect the user's requests and discuss in the committee. But, as pointed out, it is no mechanism between the committee members and users.
- Users meeting this time is an attempt to have informal but direct communication between users and KEK/J-PARC directorates. The plan is to have this meeting regularly, keeping informal. After several trials we may form a formal committee for international users.
- It is a good idea to work together with the T2K-Young. We will contact the group in the next time.
